* Make sure your child brings these items to class; Students will not be permitted to attend class without proper attire*

BALLET:

- Leotard: Solid pink, black (preferred), or white
- Tights: Solid pink, black, or white
- Ballet Skirt: Solid pink, black (preferred), or white (must be same color as leotard; *skirt is mandatory for Campus 2 students*;)
- Ballet Shoes: Solid pink (no satin slippers; please ask if unsure)

TAP:

- Leotard: Any color or style
- Tights: Solid pink, black, or white
- Tap Shoes: Solid black (Black patent beginner tap shoes not preferred; Jazz Tap Shoes preferred ; No high heels)

(Shorts may we worn over tights as well as shirts over leotards; Pants may be worn but must not be too long for safety reasons)

JAZZ/HIP HOP:

- Leotard: Any color or style
- Tights: Solid pink, black, or white
- Jazz Shoes: Solid black

(Shorts may we worn over tights as well as shirts over leotards; Pants may be worn but must not be too long for safety reasons)

Please let me know if you are having trouble finding these items

**Please keep in mind that <u>safety</u> and <u>modesty</u> are my main concerns. Make sure that clothing is fitted (i.e. not too long, too baggy, etc.) but not too tight (leotards and tights are the only exception). If you have questions about a certain piece of clothing, please err on the side of caution and ask. Please bring sweatpants, t-shirts, etc. to wear over dance clothing after class.
