In our Quest for Excellence, we have decided to make changes to the dress code to provide a more easily identifiable and professional look for the students. We may gradually move to a standard of dress, which will include polo's with the school's logo and name during the 2015-2016 school year. We did not make the change this year due to supplier changes. We are communicating these changes now in order to provide you with time to prepare or even start ordering these options this school year. Below is a quick summary of changes for the two campuses, but PLEASE take the time to review the official dress code document for a complete understanding of the standard of dress.

Campus 1 (1st – 6th grade): Everything is the same as last year, here is a reminder:

- Jeans are only permitted on Tuesdays, which is our SPOT assembly. Trouser style khaki pants in approved colors will be the new standard.
- We are no longer permitting t-shirts except for one designated day per week to be worn with jeans and it must be a CCA logoed shirt or shirt to match the SPOT color.
- Dress shirts and blouses were removed from the dress code except for days when dressing "up" is requested.
- No changes to the shorts, but they must be to the knee.

Campus 2:

- No jeans unless communicated by Administration.
- Wednesday we will allow a CCA logoed or "witness-wear" t-shirt or CCA sponsored hoody.
- Pants must be a "trouser-style" khaki pant with no more than 4 pockets.
- Cargo shorts are allowed for boys and Capri's below the knee for girls.
- Dress shirts and blouses were removed except for days when dressing "up" is requested.
- Gym shorts must be to the knee for girls and we are seeking to provide a supplier of uniform gym shorts to make compliance to this easier.
