



Dear Parent/Guardian:

According to Delaware laws and Department of Education regulations, all children entering public schools are required to have proof on file of the following requirements:

- (1) Immunizations *If you choose not to vaccinate, please contact the nursing office
 - 5 or more doses of DTap, DTP or TD vaccine (unless 4th dose was given after the 4th birthday)
 - 4 doses of IPV or OPV (unless the 3rd dose was given after the 4th birthday)
 - 2 doses of Measles, Mumps and Rubella vaccine (first dose after the age of 12 months, second dose after the 4th birthday)
 - 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
 - 2 doses of Varicella or written disease history by healthcare provider (New enterers to grades K5-7)
- (2) Physical

A current physical is needed on file. CCA requirements are as follows:

 - (1) entering CCA
 - (2) entering Kindergarten
 - (3) entering 6th grade
 - (4) entering 9th grade

A current physical is defined as a physical completed within two years
- (3) Tuberculosis

Results of Mantoux screening or risk assessment completed within the past 12 months prior to entry
- (4) Lead blood test

Documentation for children entering kindergarten or pre-school program

Calvary Christian Academy chooses to comply with the State of Delaware public school laws and regulations. If your child has had a physical within the last two years, please provide a copy of the most current complete physical. Otherwise, please have your provider complete the Delaware School Physical Examination Form during your child's physical and return to a copy to CCA within 30 days of admission.
